<u>Christmas Cards and</u> <u>Gifts</u>





Last Thursday we received the following advice relating to arrangements for the end of term from the Department of Education:

"Pupils/students often like to share Christmas cards and small gifts. This is allowable but needs to be undertaken in a controlled manner, such that it does not involve pupils/students moving and interacting outside of their usual pods or contacts. Any cards/gifts would ideally be given to a staff member directly, and then distributed by a staff member to pupils/students in a controlled way. There should be a strong emphasis on hand hygiene at all times."

In line with this advice and following some queries from parents, we have decided to alter the advice given to parents last week in relation to bringing in cards for classmates and gifts for teachers and SNAs.

We would first like to impress on parents and guardians that there is absolutely no onus on any child or family to bring in cards for classmates or gifts for teachers or SNAs however, should you wish to do so, we would ask that cards for classmates arrive in school by this Friday, where they will remain in quarantine over the weekend and teachers will distribute them in a safe manner on Monday or Tuesday of next week. Any gifts sent in for teachers and SNAs will also be stored and handled safely by staff.




Good luck to the Dublin Senior Men's Football team in the All-Ireland final versus Mayo this Sunday, 20th December.
