This obviously presents as a huge challenge to the Team Hope charity as the poorest of communities need our support now, more than ever. Team Hope have launched their 2020 campaign, encouraging us to fill virtual shoeboxes online at a cost of ε 20 each. We are asking families for their support to enable us to fill virtual shoeboxes and we will hold a Team Hope fundraiser on Friday, 27th November (Late Late Toy Show day!). No Dogs Allowed on School Grounds	Dogs are not allowed on the school grounds with the exception of assistance dogs.
Bicycles, Scooters, Flickers	Adults and children entering the school grounds on bicycles/scooters/flickers etc. should dismount at the school gate and walk through the school grounds to ensure the safety of all.
Punctuality	School gates open at 8.30am each morning. Please ensure your child arrives to their classroom no later than 8:50am each day. 4th, 5th and 6th class children must leave the school grounds at their dismissal time at 2.20pm, unless they are collecting a younger sibling at 2.30pm
Safety at Assembly and Dismissal Times	Please ensure that all children travel safely to school and home. We ask parents/guardians to exercise extreme caution if parking in the vicinity of the school at assembly and dismissal times and to adhere to applicable laws and guidelines.
Parent-Teacher Meetings	We traditionally host our face-to-face Parent-Teacher meetings in the school at the end of November/start of December. Given current restrictions we will be unable to host face-to-face meetings, so instead we will issue written mid-year Pupil Progress Reports to parents/guardians early in the second term.
